Kitchen Zoo create playful, energetic and exciting productions and activity for young audiences.

As one of the North East's most in demand companies, their productions include The Owl and the Pussycat and The Tin Foil Astronaut, made in association with ARC, plus The Three Bears at Christmas and WOLF!, made in association with Northern Stage.

During lockdown, Kitchen Zoo filmed eight broadcast shorts for ARC, delivered remote workshops, recorded stories for Durham County Council library projects, and live streamed The Emperor's New Clothes; a Kitchen Zoo and Northern Stage Christmas co-production.

They are currently working on a new version of The Tin Foil Astronaut, co-commissioned for 2021/22 by ARC and The Albany, London.

You might remember the paid opportunities we shared for Kitchen Zoo's Christmas shows at ARC, Northern Stage, and London. This week, they (Hannah Goudie-Hunter and Bob Nicholson) will be joining us for an informal chat based workshop on Zoom.
